Public Safety Day	9-Jun	Citizens will learn about Stranger Danger and participate in activities focusing on Police Work

<u>Art Week</u>		
I Spy	16-Jun	Campers will create an "I Spy" view finder to carefully observe the works of Henri Matisse and Edvard Munch. They will then create cut-out art in the style of Matisse and recreate Munch's <i>The Scream</i> .
Puzzle Me	17-Jun	The artists will study Pablo Picasso and produce a "fractured friend" puzzle-like creation, mix colors like Jackson Pollack, then paint in the fashion of Vincent Van Gogh after studying his <i>Starry Night</i> .
Repeat After Me	18-Jun	Andy Warhol's repeating picture technique will be reproduced using watercolors, we will use a chalking technique in the manner of Edgar Degas, and create a Georges Seurat dot-to-dot.
Upside Down	19-Jun	Art camp kids will create a monoprint after viewing examples from Mary Cassat, a painting following Piet Mondrain's abstract lines and paint upside down like Michelangelo.
Summer Montage	20-Jun	Vincent Van Gogh's impasto style will be revisited as we attempt to paint his famous sunflowers, each camper will create a summer montage on their own artist's canvas, then will choose an everyday item as the subject of an Andy Warhol-like painting.

In addition to our daily activities, each Art Camper will contribute to a special work of art that will hold an honored spot on the walls of Little Bitty City.
